



Already This Year: Top Ministry Milestones January – May 2022

- 1,000 *Heaven in Your Home Letters* Subscribers!** A little over two years after launching this inspiring and practical weekly email for parents, we've reached the milestone of 1,000 subscribers.
- 7 *Heaven in Your Home Workshops* reached over 500 parents to-date in 2022:** St. Philip's in Falls Church (1/15); St. Catherine's in Great Falls (2/3); St. Theresa's in Ashburn (2/8); St. John the Baptist in Front Royal (2/11); St. Bernadette's in Springfield (3/20-22); St. Luke's in McLean (5/21), and St. John Bosco in Woodstock (6/4).
- For Your Marriage, Aleteia, Columbia, and Catholic Herald.*** This spring, we were invited to become bloggers for the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' marriage and family resource site, *For Your Marriage*. And *Aleteia*, one of the world's largest Catholic websites, invited us to submit monthly articles. We were also published in the 1.3 million subscriber *Columbia* and 120,000-subscriber *Catholic Herald*.
- Heaven in Your Home Gatherings* launched at St. Philip's and strengthened at St. John's.** Within months of the launch of the *Gatherings* at St. John's, another parish indicated interest. After providing a workshop and training their core team of couples, we were delighted to see the second *Heaven in Your Home Gathering* launch on Apr. 23rd at St. Philip's.
- Our Sunday Visitor Challenge Grant.** In April, Trinity House Community entered the second round in competition to receive one of five \$100,000 challenge grants to fund innovative initiatives.
- Trinity House Café + Market served over 10,000 guests.** And our baristas donated their cash tips for Lent to support the Ukraine Solidarity Fund of the Knights of Columbus, resulting in \$500 of donations from the community.
- We've already booked 6 ministry events for the fall of 2022.** From parish-sponsored date nights to presentations for other dioceses, we are seeing heightened demand for the family-building tools Trinity House Community has to offer.
- For National Marriage Week, the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops featured the Trinity House Community ministry with a 5-minute video** entitled "Building up the Domestic Church." On YouTube, the video has already received over 500 views.
